Since January 2010, the club has grown from 30 members, struggling to get teams together and finding ourselves in the bottom half of the league, to a 130 player strong club with numerous teams in every age group, topping league tables and finishing in the top 3 in most tournaments!

We are a big family here at Infernos. We coach and play but we are about more than just netball! Girls form friendships, confidence levels increase and discipline instilled: skills which are transferrable back to the classroom.

Established teams are entered into a league which is played in Leyland on a Thursday night. Selected teams play in a Manchester league in Bury on a Sunday. On average, a team would enter 7 tournaments throughout the year. This includes a trip away (for High School girls) to places which have included Butlins, Pontins and PGL in Shropshire.

As always, our ever expanding club is always looking for skilled volunteers who are willing to commit some of their time and skills. If you feel you could offer help in some way, please speak to your daughter's coach. We are always looking for the next generation of coaches, umpires and team managers. ## COSTS

Weekly subs of £3 per session may be paid in cash for new starters for a total of 4 weeks.

After this, a monthly direct debit or standing order of £15 must be put in place. This is to be paid every month of the year and includes 12 months insurance.

## PLAYER SELECTION POLICY

At Infernos, we strive to be the best, so team selections may change regularly throughout the season, dependent upon new players joining, players who have progressed in ability and show drive and ambition to be part of a team.

We expect every player to attend training with the mindset and determination that is needed to earn a place on a team.

We adopt the policy of grouping girls together of similar ability in each team.

Player selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Applied netball skills learnt from training, in a match
- Good standard of fitness level
- Regular attendance at training
- Commitment to matches
- Gives everything a go without any hesitation
- Gives their best at all times
- Positive mental attitude towards fellow players and coaches
- Strives to improve skills when provided with training goals

The above criteria will be taken into consideration when considering which team will be best suited for your daughter.

Alternatively, your daughter will be kept in the development squad, where training will continue until the coach feels the player is ready for competition. Assessment will be undertaken on a regular basis.
